

## September 24, 2015 – Captain’s meeting minutes

- Reviewed the process for formally requesting to add a new player

### Recap

- inform board via email that you have a potential new player
- Invite new player to practice with team and for Pro evaluation
- Pro to provide feedback to board
- Team captain to fill out “LOTC Request to Add Player Mid-Season” form. Located on the LOTC website (<http://www.lotccityleague.org>)
- Received and reviewed master list of players
- Discussed Free court dates/times (see below for more detail in Open Discussions)
- Reviewed general captain’s duties and reminders for the remaining season of tennis
- Open Forum:
  - It was brought to the table that team captains were NOT involved in the decision to pay for Tuesday and Wednesday 11-12 court time. This added significant cost to players. [Captain’s Rep](#) will bring this topic to the October board meeting. Below are specific questions:
    - The captain’s would like the board and LOTC to involve captain’s in any discussion related to team fees/financial obligations that affect teams.
    - Captains would also like to know how the decision was made in the first place.
    - The B team would like to “opt out” of the court time. Is this possible?
    - Can LOTC sell the 11-12 times on dates where no games are planned? Or sell to the Pro’s?
  - An additional \$2.00 hike in court fees is expected to take place starting January 1, 2016. We would like the board to make a formal request NOT to increase court fees. [Captain’s Rep](#) will bring this topic to the October board meeting.
  - Spreadsheets – some discussion occurred regarding using spreadsheets to track teams and help with line ups. [Captain’s Rep](#) will email captain’s the sample spreadsheets
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Set tie breaks. [Stat’s Rep](#) emailed the following regarding 3<sup>rd</sup> set tie breaks and stats.
    - As far as the 3rd set tie break scores in our software - it makes no difference in our software's calculation if you use the 0/1 or the actual scores. Where it can be useful is if the Captain wants to see if someone had a competitive tie break score. The 2 reports that would show you the actual tie break

scores are "Team Season results ordered by club" and "Team season results ordered by date".
