

LOTC Board Meeting
April 8, 2026 at 5pm

1. Fun Flights – The board discussed how Fun Flights was going. It has been a great way to get more players interested in City League. The pros have been using it as a way to funnel players from their lessons. LOTC is happy with it and it has been a win win for both LOTC and City League. We hope to funnel more players through it, including players on the waitlist.
2. Waitlist – Kiki has contacted everyone on the waitlist to gauge interest in joining a LO City League team. We have 8 potential candidates on the waitlist for next year, mainly J and K level players.
3. Player participation forms - Forms went out to all players.
 - 95 returning Tier 1 players
 - 7 returning Tier 2 players
 - 102 / 7 teams = 14.57 players per team

The board discussed that we currently have enough players for 7 teams. It was discussed whether we could add another team between F and I to bridge the gap but we don't have enough players. The deadline to request teams from GPCL is April 15th.

4. Summer practices – Captains have been alerted by Hannah that all teams need to let her know ASAP if their team would like to hold summer practices indoors at LOTC. Hannah has heard from the I and K teams. Hannah is asking that captains provide time slots that work for each team.
5. Pros and practice options for next year – Amy is going to be scaling back and is looking at coaching one day a week. Hannah provided Kiki with a list of available pros. Robyn will be reaching out to captains to let them know who is available and when. Teams might need to change their practice day/time.
6. GPCL board position - Need to appoint person by April 15th. The board discussed sending an email to LOTC and see if anyone is interested with a deadline of this Sunday at 5pm. The board position is a 3-year commitment. Once a month meeting, Thursday morning at Irvington. Free lunch! Not a huge time commitment. City League leadership a plus!
