

LOTB Board Meeting Minutes
June 18, 2026
9:30 – 10:30am

Attendees: Kiki Hanover, Kelly Buhlmann, Barb Hart, Brooke Moffenbeier, and Cindy Dorado

1. Each team needs to elect new captains for the season. Kiki sent an email to all current captains asking them to send finalized rosters and captain information as soon as possible. Kiki will include that the board is able to facilitate team captain votes if needed.
 - a. Once the captains are secured, Kelly will send to (K-I team) captains to have them vote on a captains rep for next year.
2. City League June 30 deadline for registering your team - Kiki to send out reminder to all current captains. Encourage captains to get this done now and not wait until the last minute. Current 25/26 captains need to get teams registered and pay and pass along log in credentials to new captains. New 26/27 captains need to log in and fill out their rosters BEFORE June 30th.
3. LOTB Board open positions for the 26/27 season include Vice President, Recording Secretary/Website Coordinator and Captains rep (K-I team, voted on by all the captains). Kelly will be sending an email early next week to all LOTB players to gauge interest. She will follow up with all that are interested and then present to the board to vote at the August meeting.
4. Kiki is going to reach out to captains to confirm their practice days/times and which pro they are working with. There haven't been any issues reported but will check in and make sure everyone is set.
5. Barb reported that the 50% rule was still being voted on. There were a few questions regarding the rule and how it works. The board discussed how we want all players and captains to feel supported and want to normalize going to resolutions if an issue comes up. The goal is to help all players whenever possible.
6. Brooke reported that there was one resolution brought to her. The B team asked for an exception to the 50% rule for two players. They have been granted an exception each year and would like to continue that for the 2026-27 season. Resolutions put together a committee and reviewed the request. The request was granted.
7. Final board meeting for the year will be August 5th at 5pm
